Final draft of the Project to the secretariat (end of October 2012)

The Secretariat urges project leaders to submit the final drafts by the end of October to allow necessary time for editing and layout.

Editing

Language editing will be done for all papers produced by the SAIs where English is not official language. Editing is done by the SAI of New Zealand.
