

# Where are governments with their climate action? First results of the ClimateScanner assessment



## Panel discussion at the COP29 14 November 2024 at 11:30-13:00 Azerbaijan Pavilion

In November 2022, a global initiative, ClimateScanner, was launched at the International Congress of Supreme Audit Institutions (SAI) in Brazil. By COP29, 141 SAIs acting as their governments' external auditor have been engaged with the ClimateScanner, and 240 auditors have been trained to assess the actions taken by national governments on climate change. This rapid review concentrates on three thematic areas: governance, public policies, and finance.

The event ***"Where are governments with their climate action – First results of the ClimateScanner assessments"*** is organized by the INTOSAI Working Group on Environmental Auditing, SAI Brazil as the Chair of the INTOSAI, and SAI Azerbaijan. SAI Brazil will present the first consolidated results of ClimateScanner, followed by a country example. In a panel discussion, SAI experts discuss SAIs' experiences and lessons learned from the assessment framework as well as the possibilities of improving effective climate governance and accountability at the national level. The event will conclude with remarks from stakeholders.
